Courses or course sequences addressing Critical Analysis of Identity and Equity in the United States (CAIEUS) must meet a majority of the student learning outcomes (SLOs). During the Fall 2018, Spring 2019, and Fall 2019 semesters, Virginia Tech offered 38 Pathways courses that included the Core Concept of CAIEUS.




Figure 1. (n=1,793)




Figure 2. (n=1,251)




Figure 3. (n=641)




Figure 4. (n=222)




Figure 5. (n=830)
